3. Q: Are there any overseas exchange programmes during my study?

A: The Humanities Programme provides students with opportunities to study abroad in order to expand their educational and cultural horizons. Previously, our Summer Study Tour visited Germany, Taiwan and China. Every year, many students spend one semester or a year in overseas universities, and they invariably come back with unforgettable experiences as well as a newly-gained sense of confidence. They may go to a wide variety of places for exchange, such as Australia, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Japan, Korea, the Netherlands, Norway, Sweden, Taiwan and the USA. Since 2017, the

department has established a regular 2-week exchange programme with the Academy of Arts & Design of Tsinghua University.

4. Q: Could the credits gained from exchange be transferred?

A: Subject to the consent of your Head of Department/Programme Director, credits earned at the host institution could be transferred back to HKBU. You are strongly advised to obtain consent from your Head of Department/Programme Director before enrolling in the courses.
