Q: Does "translation" need to interview? Any double counting in English?

A: No interview is required for JUPAS applicants and no double counting in English.

Q: What is the minimum requirement for DSE Chinese and English for entering your programme?

A: For JUPAS applicants: 3 in Chinese and 3 in English

Q: Are the courses all conducted in English?

A: Not 100% English, Cantonese and Putonghua would also be spoken sometimes.

Q: Do you have any mentoring programme for the freshmen?

A: Yes, each student will be assigned a mentor (an academic staff member). He/she can seek advice from the mentor up to graduation.

Q: What is the employment situation of translation graduates?

A: In addition to translation and interpreting of all kinds, the Department's graduates have gone into a range of professions that demand advanced proficiency in bilingual communication and expert intercultural competence. They have found jobs as court interpreters, government translators, PR managers and news reporters. Others have gone into fields such as arts management, magazine journalism, bilingual editing, foreign diplomacy and marketing.
